## HISTORY | MISSION | GOALS

The Mt. Vernon Township High School District #201 Foundation was formed in 2005 by a group of MVTHS supporters who were concerned about the future of the school. This group of citizens did not want financial concerns to hinder the opportunities available to the students. The Foundation was thus formed to promote excellence in education at MVTHS.

The Foundation wishes to support programs that are not being sufficiently funded by tax dollars or regular revenue sources. It is the Foundation's continuing goal to help fund educational needs of students and establish an endowment for the future.



The MVTHS Foundation is a non-profit corporation and tax exempt organization under Section 501 c3 of the Internal Revenue Code. A rotating Board of Directors composed of citizens, teachers, and students meets monthly with an annual meeting each August.

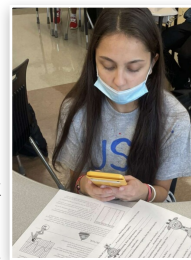


- Disarticulated Skeletons and Forensic Anthropology Kit

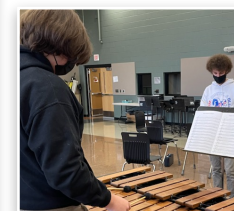
